Trade School Market Insights

A quarterly update on the trade school market in the United States.



About Trade School Market Insights



VI's market research team publishes quarterly reports on the higher education market, with this one focusing on trade/technical schools and vocational education. They analyze reliable data sources to provide valuable insights and recommendations. This report uses proprietary categorizations to give an in-depth look at the growing trade school market.

This report primarily covers a first-of-its-kind analysis of National Center for Education Statistics (NCES) IPEDS data, in which we go beyond the standard NCES and Carnegie classifications to identify Trade Schools specifically. These efforts clarify the enrollment picture at Trade Schools and find that these institutions are outperforming universities.

In addition to this enrollment data, industry sources and survey data show that the market for Trade School is growing in terms of revenues, and that more and more potential students (both teens and adults) indicate a preference for enrolling in Trade Schools.

- As of 2023 there were 1.5 million students enrolled in Trade Schools across the United States. Furthermore, the U.S. Census Bureau shows that an additional ~2.5 million students are enrolled in technical/vocational education that are not enrolled at colleges or universities (including Trade Schools).
- The pandemic dramatically changed enrollment growth in trade schools. Total Trade School enrollment grew 4.9% from 2020 to 2023 (1.6% CAGR). This represents a significant acceleration as total Trade School enrollment declined at -0.8% CAGR pre-pandemic (2017 to 2020).
- Growth isn't evenly distributed among Trade Schools. In particular, Culinary Arts Schools (9.4% CAGR) and Healthcare Trade Schools (3.9% CAGR) have seen significant enrollment growth while Maintenance and Repair Schools have seen a decline (-3.3% CAGR).

- Search interest for Trade Schools has grown at a 10.3% CAGR since 2017 (while enrollment grew at a 0.8% CAGR through 2023).
- The percentage of both teens and adults interested in enrolling in trade school almost doubled during the pandemic.



- The 15 largest private Trade Schools enroll 18.6% of all Trade School enrollments. In 2023 these market leaders enrolled an average of about 19,000 students.
- The 15 largest public Trade Schools enroll 14.9% of all Trade School enrollments. In 2023 these market leaders enroll an average of about 15,000 students.





Enrollment Trends




Trade School revenue grew at a 0.4% CAGR from 2017 to 2023

From 2017 to 2023 total Trade School revenue grew at a 0.4% CAGR. During that time revenues of Trade Schools grew faster at a 0.7% CAGR.

Total Trade School Enrollment and Market Revenue by Year (2017 to 2023 with Revenue Projections to 2030)






While the Trade School market is projected to grow at a 5-7% CAGR, the broader higher education market is projected to grow at a 2-4% CAGR.

- Trade School enrollment and aggregate market revenue tends to (unsurprisingly) track together. Changes in enrollment, however, result in more significant changes in revenue.
- → In 2018 it was projected by Statista that total Trade School revenues would grow at a 2.0% CAGR through 2023, meaning that growth has not met expectations in recent years.¹



Trade School revenue grew 11.1% from 2020 to 2023

From 2017 to 2020, total Trade School revenues declined 6.1% while enrollments declined 2.3%. Since 2020, revenues have grown 11.1% and enrollment 4.9%.





While Trade School enrollment grew 4.9% from 2020 to 2023, university enrollment declined 0.6% (Fall 2020 to Fall 2023).


- → Pre-COVID, Trade Schools saw enrollments decline 2.3% (from 2017 to 2020). Revenues brought in by Trade Schools declined more significantly than enrollments, declining 6.1% during that same time.
- Post-COVID, total Trade School enrollment grew 4.9% while total revenues brought in by these schools grew 11.1%.



Healthcare Trade Schools are leading in enrollment growth

From 2017 to 2023, 12-month unduplicated headcount at Healthcare Trade Schools grew at a 3.9% CAGR.

→ All Trade School categories combined saw enrollment grow at a 0.3% CAGR from 2017 to 2023. Growth was not evenly distributed, however, as Healthcare Trade Schools, Beauty and Wellness Schools, and Other Trade Schools experienced growth while Multiple Specialty Schools, Skilled Trade Schools, and Adult/Vocational Schools all experienced declines.



Culinary Schools are the fastest growing sub-type of Trade School

While Healthcare schools are the fastest growing type of Trade Schools, Culinary Arts schools lead growth of sub-types of Trade Schools.



Trade School enrollments are mostly non-degree

About 60% of Trade School enrollments are in non-degree programs with another 20% being in associate's degrees and the remaining 20% in bachelor's.

Percent of Trade School Enrollment by Program Level



- → 60% of Trade School enrollments are in non-degree programs, however 67% of programs offered by Trade Schools are non-degree programs.²
- → 8% of programs offered by Trade Schools are bachelor's degrees, however 20% of enrollments in Trade Schools are at the bachelor's level.²





Demand Trends




Search traffic for Trade Schools grew at a 10.3% CAGR from 2017 to 2024

From 2017 to 2023, Trade School enrollment grew at a 0.4% CAGR. During that same time, search traffic for Trade Schools grew at an 8.0% CAGR.


- → Search traffic for Trade Schools is growing faster than enrollment at Trade Schools, with enrollments growing at a 0.4% CAGR and search traffic growing at an 8.0% CAGR from 2017 to 2023.
- Thus far in 2024, search traffic for Trade Schools is up 27.1%. IBISWorld, on the other hand, expects that Trade School revenues to decline 0.4% year-over-year in 2024.



Interest in enrolling in Trade Schools is growing

Pre-pandemic to post-pandemic, interest in attending Trade School nearly doubled among both teens and adults.

Interest in Enrolling in Trade School by Age Group



- → Pre-pandemic, only 4% of teens indicated interest in enrolling in Trade Schools. After the pandemic, that had grown to 7%.³
- → Pre-pandemic, only 10% of adults indicated interest in enrolling in Trade Schools. After the pandemic, that had grown to 18%.⁴






Competitive Landscape



The largest private Trade Schools enroll about 19,000 students on average

The 15 largest *private* Trade Schools collectively enroll 281,570 students, or 18.6% of all Trade School enrollments.



The largest public Trade Schools enroll about 15,000 students on average

The 15 largest *private* Trade Schools collectively enroll 281,570 students, or 14.9% of all Trade School enrollments.




Market Profiles -Adult Education/Vocational Schools



Enrollment in Adult Ed./Voc. Schools has declined but is starting to rebound

While the trend improved throughout the pandemic, since 2017, enrollment in Adult Education/Vocational Schools is declining at a -2.5% CAGR.




- → From 2017 to 2020 (pre-pandemic), enrollment in Adult Education/Vocational Schools was declining at a -5.0% CAGR.
- → Post-pandemic (2020 to 2023), enrollment in these schools has rebounded, growing at a 0.1% CAGR. Even with this growth, the long term trend is negative.



The 10 largest Adult Ed./Voc. Schools enroll 2,100 students on average

Adult Education/Vocational Schools tend to be small and localized with an average enrollment of only 2,100 among market leaders.

- Leading Adult Education/Vocational Schools have an average enrollment of only about 2,100 students.
- → The top 10 largest Adult Education/Vocational Schools enroll 31.5% of all students enrolled in this type of institution.






Market Profiles -Beauty and Wellness Schools



Beauty and Enrollment Schools are growing strongly post-pandemic

From 2020 to 2023, enrollment in Beauty and Wellness Schools has grown at a 3.4% CAGR to a total of 239,022 in 2023.






The largest Beauty and Wellness Schools enroll 8,300 students on avg.

The 10 largest Beauty and Wellness Schools enroll 83,069 students, or 34.8% of all Beauty and Wellness School enrollments.

- The 10 largest Beauty and Wellness Schools enroll 34.8% of all Beauty and Wellness School enrollments.
- → Leading Beauty and Wellness Schools have an average enrollment of about 8,300 students per institution.



Cosmetology Schools enroll more than 200k students and are growing

While Cosmetology Schools are large and growing, Massage Schools have more modest enrollment totals and are declining at a -3.1% CAGR.




Market Profiles - Culinary Arts Schools



Culinary Arts School enrollment is growing and accelerating

From 2017 to 2020, enrollment in Culinary Arts Schools grew at a 5.5% CAGR. Post-pandemic, the compound annual growth rate accelerated to 13.4%.


→ From 2017 to 2023, total enrollment in Culinary Arts Schools grew at a 9.4% CAGR. The compound annual growth rate is accelerating, as it was 5.5% pre-pandemic and 13.4% post-pandemic.



The largest Culinary Arts Schools enroll 2,200 students on average

The 10 largest Culinary Arts Schools enroll 22,394 students, or 99.4% of all Culinary Arts School enrollments.

Top 10 Largest Culinary Arts Schools and Recent Growth Rate



- → The 10 largest Culinary Arts Schools enroll 99.4% of all students enrolled in Culinary Arts Schools, indicating a high degree of market concentration.
- → The leading Culinary Arts Schools enroll an average of about 2,200 students per institution.






Market Profiles - Healthcare Trades Schools



Healthcare Trade School enrollment is growing but has decelerated

From 2017 to 2020, Healthcare Trade School enrollment grew at a 4.4% CAGR. From 2020 to 2023, enrollment at these schools grew at a 3.3% CAGR.


→ Healthcare Trade Schools are growing at a healthy 3.9% CAGR since 2017, although growth did decelerate during and after the pandemic.



The 10 largest Healthcare Trade Schools enroll 16,100 students on average

The 10 largest Healthcare Trade Schools enroll 160,716 students, or 54.6% of all enrollments in Healthcare Trade Schools.

- → The 10 largest Healthcare Trade Schools enroll 54.6% of all students enrolled in Healthcare Trade Schools.
- → Among these market leaders there is an average of about 16,100 students enrolled per institution.






Market Profiles Multiple Specialty Trade/ Technical Schools



Enrollment in Multidisciplinary Tech Schools is growing post-pandemic

After declining at a -0.7% CAGR from 2017 to 2020, enrollment in Multidisciplinary Technical Schools is growing at a modest 0.1% post-pandemic (2020 to 2023).






The 10 largest Multidisciplinary Technical Schools enroll 16,200 students on average

The 10 largest Multidisciplinary Technical Schools enroll 162,304 students collectively, or 22.1% of all enrollments in this type of Trade School.



The Skilled Trades School market is concentrated, as the 10 largest providers enroll 96.6% of students enrolled in these schools.

Maint. and Repair Schools are the largest Skilled Trades School sub-type

While Maint. and Repair Schools are the largest Skilled Trades School sub-type, the fastest growing sub-type is Welding Schools.
